

To the public of the unorganized portion of Davison County [former Mitchell Township]:

To complete the rural 911 addressing project for Davison County the Highway Department will be installing 911 number signs as required by the Davison County 911 addressing ordinance. The Ordinance requires the sign be placed at a location as listed in Section 4.

Section 4. Numbers to be displayed

Every person having a home or business establishment within the unincorporated area of the county is hereby required to display in a prominent place, which by this Ordinance shall be to the right of driveway (not less than 2' (two feet) or more than 6' (six feet)) from road surface of said approach and the right-of-way in so far as geographical features allow. The building number shall be assigned by the 911 Addressing Director as provided by this ordinance. Groups of homes serviced by one driveway/access way shall have an address sign posted at the point where the primary access to those homes intersects with the main road.

The sign is required by Ordinance and to be installed as required by the same Ordinance. Once the sign is installed it shall remain in the location and in the condition as installed or the property owner will be found in violation of ordinance 070108-01.

Section 7. Penalty for Violating Ordinance

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a violation of said ordinance and shall be punished pursuant to SDCL7-18A-2. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

This will be the completion of the initial planned compliance with the State of South Dakota state wide 911 addressing in Davison County. The location and style of sign is to provide uniformity for emergency responders.
