When to Call:

We respond to any disaster including:

- Residential fires
- Natural disasters such as tornadoes, winter storms, wildfires, and floods
- Manmade disasters – accidental or intentional – such as hazardous materials releases, transportation incidents, and acts of terrorism
- We support search and rescue or recovery operations

Our Services:

- Immediate emergency assistance to disaster victims in the form of:
 - Shelter
 - Food
 - Clothing
 - Emergency medical prescriptions or equipment
 - Immediate needs such as personal care items and clean-up kits
- Mass Care:
 - Shelter operations
 - Fixed or mobile feeding operations
 - Distribution of relief supplies
- Assistance to Emergency Responders:
 - Feeding and temporary shelter
- Assistance in reuniting family members separated by the disaster
