MASTER TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Davison County

The Davison County Master Transportation Plan identifies current transportation system deficiencies, future system needs, and future transportation system improvements planned and prioritized in Davison County. The development of the plan is being guided by a Study Advisory Team comprised of staff members of the partnering agencies. A consultant, HR Green, Inc., is facilitating the preparation of the plan.

Throughout the planning process for the Davison County Master Transportation Plan existing and future transportation needs were identified. Nine need types were identified for further evaluation, including:

• Bridge

- Traffic
- Pedestrian/Bicycle

IntersectionDrainage

- Unofficial Bypass Routes
 Corridor
- Maintenance
- Urbanized Growth-related

The Master Transportation Plan provides a series of proposed projects with the goal of balancing needs with regulatory requirements and technical constraints. Provided with each proposed project is a planning-level cost estimate based on current industry planning-level estimating procedures. Each project also has a proposed priority of

Short-, Medium-, or Long-Term (0-10 years, 11-20 years, or 20 or more years). Projects are divided into five categories: Intersection, Roadway Segment, Multi-modal, System Management and Policy, and Bridges.

Based on the proposed projects, the Davison County Master Transportation Plan evaluates the ability of the existing county transportation budget to meet the identified needs within the Plan. Utilizing recent transportation budgets, the Master Transportation Plan outlines the additional funding required to address yearly transportation funding gaps. Without changes in transportation revenues the Davison County transportation budget will be unable to support system preservation and maintenance and the recommended improvements outlined in the Master Transportation Plan.
