The new HVAC Control System would include:

- -Replacing the thermostats, space sensors, duct mounted sensors and immersion sensors
- -Existing actuators, relays, transformers and panels will be reused, as needed
- -Computer based program, which includes remote web access, better graphics, easier scheduling, easier to use trending and other features.

Commissioners would like more information regarding safeguards and additional security that may be purchased, as part of the project. No action was taken.
