CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Bode called the regular meeting of the Davison County Board of Commissioners to order at 9:00 a.m. Members of the Board present were Bode, Reider, Kiner, Claggett. Absent Weitala. Also present was Auditor Kiepke.

PLEDGE

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairperson Bode.

APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Kiner, second by Claggett to approve the minutes from the February 12, 2019 meeting. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Commissioner Claggett announced that Chairperson Bode was elected as the Southeast Central District representative to the SDACC executive board.

REPORTS

Chairperson Bode reported that she attended the Weed & Pest conference in Huron on February 21 and 22. She said that Chairperson Deb Schultz put on a wonderful conference. Not only did they have topics related to weeds and pests, they had speakers about every day life such as a drug addict who is a doctor.

Auditor Kiepke reported that she would be going to Pierre again to testify against HB1178, which would shorten absentee voting time and take away voters rights, among other things.

ADDED TAX APPEALS

As there was nobody present to appeal their added taxes, the meeting continued.

AUTOMATIC SUPPLEMENT

Motion by Claggett, second by Reider to sign letter of intent to gift that portion of Lot B necessary to “square up” Lot C, such portion of Lot B being a tract approximately 57.07’ east to west by 116’ north to south and immediately adjacent to the west and south boundaries of Lot C, all being a Subdivision of Block 1, Sunnyside Addition to the City of Mitchell, Davison County, SD, to Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones. All members present voted aye. Motion carried.

Resolution to Gift Property

Dba Stepping Stones**

Whereas, SDCL 6-5-2 states that any political subdivision may convey and transfer any real or personal property which is held or owned by it, the title to which has been obtained and which is not held for public use or which is about to be abandoned for public purposes, to another political subdivision or nonprofit corporation for public, charitable, or humanitarian purposes and accommodation without offering the property for sale and without requiring the political subdivision or nonprofit corporation to pay for the property; and

Whereas, SDCL 6-5-3 states that if the governing body deems it advisable and to the best interest of the public to convey any such property to another political subdivision or nonprofit corporation pursuant to § 6-5-2, it shall by resolution direct that said property be so conveyed and transferred. Thereupon a deed of conveyance shall be made to the political subdivision or nonprofit corporation, which deed vests in the grantee all the right, title and interest of the transferor in and to the real property so conveyed; and

Whereas, Davison County owns that portion of Lot B necessary to “square up” Lot C, such portion of Lot B being a tract approximately 57.07’ east to west by 116’ north to south and immediately adjacent to the west and south boundaries of Lot C, all being a Subdivision of Block 1, Sunnyside Addition to the City of Mitchell, Davison County, SD, as generally appears in the circled area on the attached diagram; and

Whereas, Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones abuts aforementioned property and would like to utilize the property for clients, primarily for security purposes; and

Whereas, Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones is a non-profit organization.

Therefore, be it resolved that Davison County gifts that portion of Lot B necessary to “square up” Lot C, such portion of Lot B being a tract approximately 57.07’ east to west by 116’ north to south and immediately adjacent to the west and south boundaries of Lot C, all being a Subdivision of Block 1, Sunnyside Addition to the City of Mitchell, Davison County, SD, as generally appears in the circled area on the attached diagram, to Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones, with the following conditions.

1. The property will be gifted with a reverter clause, to be approved by the Davison County States Attorney, meaning that if Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones becomes a for profit entity, closes its doors, moves or for any other reason no longer occupies the current building, the property described above will revert back to Davison County; and
2. Dakota Counseling Institute dba Stepping Stones will be responsible for paying ALL costs for surveys, platting, title work and any other costs associated with the land being gifted to them from Davison County.

PURR ‘N RUFF PRESENTATION

Gail Hahne of Purr ‘n Ruff Rescue appeared before the Board to talk about funding. She said the funding she receives from Davison County is strictly for Davison County animals. She said if other counties bring an animal to her, she requests a \$100 transfer fee as well as an intake sheet be filled out. If the county won't provide the funding she asks, at the very least, they vaccinate the animal and or provide a 50 lb bag of dog food.

She explained that an animal is held for 72 hours in hopes of finding the owner. If, after 72 hours the owner is not found, the animal is micro-chipped, vaccinated, spayed and/or neutered. Ms. Hahne provided a list of costs for these services which can be found on file in the Auditor's office.

She said that Paul Claggett is writing grants for Spaying/Neutering as well as one for Veterinary Medical Services and one for the Pet Pantry.

One of the concerns of Chairperson Bode was that they don't really know where the animals come from. Sad as it sounds, sometimes people drive across county lines and dump animals. She would like to have a conversation with the sheriff's office to see how they are assisting with the situation.

Ms. Hahne reported there may be a new pet pantry opening in Mitchell this Spring.

JAIL OVERTIME INFORMATION

Lieutenant Connie Harr presented a comprehensive outline of the overtime that has occurred in the past, why it has occurred and her ideas for reducing it. She stated that basically the only things that should cause overtime in the future is training and shakedown. She has to have people work and train at the same time. She explained that she schedules the same training once in two consecutive months so that everybody is able to participate.

Harr further reported that she has added part-time staff from two to five to reduce overtime in the jail. The full report may be found on file at the Davison County Auditor's office.
