# Domestic Disaster Response Capabilities

Team Rubicon is an international non-profit disaster response organization that unites the skills and experiences of military veterans with first responders to rapidly deploy disaster response teams, free of charge to communities affected by disasters across the country. Team Rubicon currently maintains a roster of over 45,000 volunteers able to deploy throughout the United States. Team Rubicon stands able to deploy volunteers in the following mobilization times:

- · within 12 hours: 10+ volunteers
- · within 48 hours: 20+ volunteers
- within 96 hours: 30+ volunteers

(Note: Depending on assigned task(s) from city, county, volunteer numbers can be scaled significantly.)



Team Rubicon actively tracks all volunteer hours to assist the local, county, and state governments served in Robert Stafford Act or Emergency Management Assistance Compact grant reporting.

Team Rubicon has fully adopted the Incident Command System. All volunteers are trained with a baseline knowledge of the ICS. All Command Staff volunteers are required to complete a more in-depth ICS curriculum.

HAZARD MITIGATION (FIRE/FLOOD)

Team Rubicon deploys equipped with all the resources required to provide the capabilities above including: personal protective equipment, hand tools, solar-powered electrical suites, and Palantir intelligence analysis and mapping suite (mobile and static platforms). All incident management personnel are trained in the application of Incident Command System (ICS) in compliance with the National Incident Management System and deployed volunteers are trained in the basics of ICS. Team Rubicon deploys as a self-sustaining unit.

Team Rubicon has responded to numerous natural disasters across the United States. The flexibility of our organization allows us to operate in two distinct ways, both free of charge:

#### TACTICAL BRANCH, SINGLE RESOURCE UNIT. **OR TASK FORCE**

Team Rubicon can work under the direction of a governmental entity or agency (based on requested function) and integrate fully into an existing Incident Command System structure to perform disaster response functions.

### NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION (NGO)

Team Rubicon is a voting member of the National Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (NVOAD). Team Rubicon can integrate into national, state, or community VOAD efforts to provide its services to survivors, free of charge.
