SUMMARY: From the Sheriff's Office Report: UNIT 1 WAS TRAVELING EASTBOUND ON INTERSTATE 90. UNIT 1 MADE CONTACT WITH ICE ON THE ROAD AND RAN OFF THE ROAD LEFT. UNIT 1 ENTERED THE MEDIAN AND OVERTURNED ONTO THE DRIVER'S SIDE. DRIVER OF UNIT 1 STATED HIS VEHICLE LEFT THE ROADWAY DUE TO A HIT OF PATCH OF ICE. AT THE TIME OF THE ACCIDENT, I-90 MM319 WAS EXTREMELY ICY DUE TO FREEZING RAIN. NEAR UNIT 1 WAS ANOTHER SEMI THAT HAD OVERTURNED, THE TWO ACCIDENTS ARE UNRELATED AND THE VEHICLES DID NOT COLLIDE WITH EACH OTHER. DUE TO THE SEMI'S OVERTURNING, DIESEL SPILLED INTO THE MEDIAN. NEITHER DRIVER OR THE PASSENGER OF UNIT 1 REQUIRED MEDICAL ATTENTION. DUE TO THE ICY ROADS, UNIT 1 WAS TOWED AWAY WHEN ROAD CONDITIONS APPROVED. UNIT 1'S TRAILER WAS LOADED WITH PRODUCT AND THE DRIVER AND PASSENGER

WERE TRANSPORTED TO A MOTEL ROOM IN MITCHELL FOR THE EVENING.

UNIT 1 WAS TRAVELING EASTBOUND ON I-90 UNIT 1 MADE CONTACT WITH ICE ON THE ROAD. UNIT 1 WENT INTO THE MEDIAN AND UNIT 1 LANDED ON IT'S DRIVER'S SIDE. I ARRIVED ON SCENE OF I-90 AND MILE MARKER 319. I OBSERVED A SEMI WITH A TRAILER ON IT'S DRIVER'S SIDE. THERE WAS ALSO ANOTHER SEMI ON IT'S DRIVER'S SIDE, THE TWO ACCIDENTS WERE UNRELATED. UNIT 1 INFORMED ME THEY HAD CARGO AND UNIT 1 WAS FULLY LOADED. BOTH SEMI'S STAYED IN THE MEDIAN DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS WERE TOO DANGEROUS FOR A WRECKER TO APPROACH THE SEMI'S DUE TO THE ICE. DUE TO THE SEMI'S BEING OVERTURNED, DIESEL SPILLED INTO THE MEDIAN. I ASKED UNIT 1 IF THEY WANTED MEDICAL ATTENTION AND IT WAS DENIED. UNIT 1 DID HAVE A PASSENGER THAT WAS UNINJURED. .
