

DRAINAGE BOARD
December 1, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Larson called the regular meeting of the Davison County Drainage Board to order at 12:00 p.m. Deputy Auditor Matthews took roll call as follows: Members of the Board present were Jay Larson, Gregg Bult, Mark Klumb, Brenda Bode. Ex-Officio members present were Drainage Administrator Bathke, and Deputy Drainage Administrator Wegleitner. Absent Board Members Chet Edinger, Jerry Buchholz, Commissioner Kiner, and Ex-Officio members Highway Superintendent Weinberg, and DOE Love.

MEETING EXPECTATIONS

Chairman Larson recited expectations of the meeting.

A checklist of items required in accordance with the Davison County Drainage Ordinance and SDCL 46A-10A will be considered on each permit. The checklist is on file in the Davison County Auditor's office and the Drainage Administrator's office.

APPROVE AGENDA

Motion by Bult, second by Klumb to approve the agenda for the December 1, 2021 meeting as amended adding Luebke Farms, Inc as an agenda item under Administratively Approved Applications. A roll call vote was taken as follows Larson-Aye, Bult-Aye, Klumb-Aye, Bode-Aye, Edinger-Absent, Buchholz-Absent, Kiner-Absent. Motion carried.

DECLARE CONFLICTS OF INTERESTS

Chairman Larson asked for any conflicts of interests. No conflicts were declared.

APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Klumb, second by Bode to approve the minutes of the September 21, 2021 meeting. A roll call vote was taken as follows Larson-Aye, Bult-Aye, Bode-Aye, Klumb-Aye, Edinger-Absent, Buchholz-Absent, Kiner-Absent. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT & CITIZEN COMPLAINTS

Chairman Larson asked for any public input for items not on the agenda and reminded them that no action will be taken.

BLINDAUER DRAINAGE

Chad Blindauer has applied to the Davison County Drainage Commission to recommend granting a drainage permit. This request is pursuant to Section 2 of the Davison County Drainage Ordinance as adopted on 8/27/2013. The property to be drained is legally described as the NW ¼ of Section 18 T104N-R60W Davison County. The outlet will be in the same quarter.

Drainage Administrator Bathke presented the application. The plan is to install approximately 2,000' of 4" drain tile from just south of 246th St. to the un-named creek, which then drains into North Dry Run Creek. This eventually drains into the James River, then the Missouri River.

- b. Applicant and necessary neighbors notified November 18, 2021.
- c. Published in the paper November 24, 2021.

Administrator Bathke explained he received no calls from abutting property owners.

Based on the findings, after consideration of Section 2:05 of the Davison County Drainage Ordinance and SDCL 46A-10A-20, motion by Klumb, second by Bult to approve the application as presented. A roll call vote was taken as follows. Bult – Aye, Klumb- Aye, Bode – Aye Larson – Aye, Edinger- Absent, Buchholz-Absent, Kiner-Absent. Motion carried.

Luebke farms is cleaning out a road ditch and removing an approach. Highway Superintendent Weinberg was involved in the project approval.


SET DATE AND TIME FOR NEXT MEETING
