

Plan Components

Existing Conditions

This section of the Davison County Master Transportation Plan will highlight the existing conditions of the Davison County transportation system. The section will include: safety and traffic issues, bridge conditions, crash history analysis, and multimodal gaps.

Needs Assessment

The Needs Assessment of the Davison County Master Transportation Plan will use data collected from Davison County residents through the Internet Survey to identify where and by what mode the transportation system is being used. This section will also include a traffic forecast for the year 2035 to identify where traffic increases are likely to occur.

Major Roads Plan

The Major Roads Plan will outline a roadway classification hierarchy throughout Davison County. Additionally, the section will propose a roadway system map to meet the needs of Davison County residents through the 20-year planning timeframe.

Alternative Transportation Plan

This section will propose multimodal transportation improvements or service expansion that may be necessary during the 20-year planning timeframe.

Roadway Design and Policy Guidelines

This section of the Davison County Master Transportation Plan will cover a range of roadway design standards, guidance, and policy. This section will provide typical sections to help visualize roadway design. Included in this section will be pavement and maintenance performance standards, and guidance on asset management policy.

Implementation Plan

The Implementation Plan will provide an overview of recommended projects by type that may need to be undertaken by 2035. The projects will also be prioritized to improve existing conditions and meet the needs of the future before issues arise.

Funding the Transportation Network

The Funding the Transportation Network section of the Davison County Master Transportation Plan will review available funding sources, the on-going legislative discussion, and future project costs. This section will provide guidance on how Davison County can pay for transportation maintenance and improvements.
