SHERIFF HARR

Sheriff Harr inquired about purchasing two new portable radios. The estimated cost for both radios is \$6,052.50. Motion by Nebelsick to approve; second by Blaalid. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Sheriff Harr asked to hire Hanson County Sheriff Brandon Wingert as a temporary deputy during Dakotafest. Wages will be reimbursed to the county. Brandon will work August 19-21, 2025, at \$40 an hour. Motion by Blaalid; second by Kiner to approve. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Whereas, SDCL 7-21-32.2 states that no expenditures shall be charged to the line item authorized for by SDCL 7-21-6.1, but such appropriated amount may be transferred, by resolution of the board, to any other appropriation in which

insufficient amounts were provided or for items for which no appropriation was provided. When transfers are made from the contingency budget to other appropriations, whose revenue is provided by other than general fund revenues, a transfer of fund balances may be made from the county general fund to such other fund in the amount of the budget transfer.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the following contingency transfers be made for the 2025 budget year:

Transfer from the General Fund Contingency Budget ll2 in the amount of \$28,000 to: 113-Insurance.
