CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Reider called the Davison County Board of Commissioners meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Kiner, Nebelsick, Blaalid, and Chairman Reider. Also present was Auditor Wingert.

PLEDGE

Commissioner Reider opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVE AGENDA

Motion by Claggett; second by Nebelsick to approve the agenda as amended. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Claggett; second by Nebelsick to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2025, meeting.

PUBLIC INPUT

Steve Sibson stated that he attended the property tax meeting in Sioux Falls. He told the commissioners that he feels counties are being represented well.

Dwight Stadler told the commissioners that per the new Robert's Rules of Order, a motion is no longer needed to approve the minutes.

POTENTIAL QUORUM

Commissioners were invited to the High Plains Soybean Processing Plant on 9/9/25 for the open house. There may be 3 or more commissioners in the facility at one time. They will be taking tours of the facility. No business will be discussed.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT WEINBERG

Highway Superintendent Weinberg brought the bridge bids for structures 18-130-183 and 18-170-053. CDI reviewed the bids for accuracy and ensured the SD DOT bid concurrence. Motion by Blaalid to accept Timmons Construction for 18-130-183 and Midwest Contracting for 18-170-053. The motion was seconded by Nebelsick to approve and award the bids. All in favor - aye. Motion passed.

Gravel pit - motion by Blaalid; second by Kiner to rescind the motion from 6/24/2025 where ENG Services was awarded the bid. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

A new bid will be posted for the gravel pit. Bids must be sealed for crushed gravel. All bids must be received by 5:00 P.M., on August 11 in the Davison County Auditor's Office. Bids will be opened on August 12, 2025, at the Davison County Commissioners Chambers. Bids will be received for 100,000 tons more or less of ¾" for crushed gravel from any pit location in Davison County. Project will be completed by 10/30/2025 with payments to start in 2026 and two additional payments the following years. Motion by Blaalid; second by Claggett. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Weinberg discussed an application for Bridge Improvement Grant (BIG) PE FUNDS - location 4.9 miles south and 1.5 miles west of Mitchell - Bridge #18-140-149. Total project amount \$48,608.18; requested amount from grant is \$38,886.55 with a

\$9,721.64 match from the county. Motion by Nebelsick; second by Kiner to approve Chairman Reider to sign. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Blaalid to amend the five-year plan to include the 18-140-149 bridge. The motion was seconded by Nebelsick. Roll call vote was held as follows: Claggett - aye; Kiner - aye, Nebelsick – aye; Blaalid – aye; Reider - aye. Motion Carried.
