**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Reider called the Davison County Board of Commissioners meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Nebelsick, Blaalid, and Chairman Reider. Also present was Auditor Wingert. Commissioner Kiner was absent from the meeting.

**PLEDGE**

Commissioner Reider opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**APPROVE AGENDA**

Motion by Nebelsick; second by Claggett to approve the agenda as amended. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

**APPROVE MINUTES**

Motion by Nebelsick; second by Claggett to approve the minutes of the July 22, 2025, meeting.

**PUBLIC INPUT**

Joann Garretts informed the commission about an incident that occurred while South Rowley Street was being chip sealed by a third-party business. Contact information was provided to Joann to discuss the chip sealing/tar incident.

Jai with Anchor'D Recovery gave a presentation on his new facility, which is opening on 8/1/25.

Auditor Wingert gave a presentation on South Dakota open meeting laws. Informational only.

Tate Schoenfelder inquired about selling 50/50 raffle tickets on 8/2/25 at Legacy Links (Wild Oak) to support the Hanson County School District's golf program. Motion by Blaalid; second by Nebelsick. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Jordan Thuringer of Tech Solutions gave an overview on the upcoming 2026 contract. No action taken.

**EMPLOYEE CHANGES**

Motion by Blaalid; second by Claggett to approve the voluntary resignation of Corrections Officer Victoria Van Sickle (part-time) effective 7/24/25. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Blaalid; second by Claggett to accept the involuntary resignation of Employee #99118 effective 7/29/25. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Claggett; second by Nebelsick to approve to advertise and rehire for the DOE assessor position.

**REVIEW OF PHONE VOTE**

Voice vote was held on 7,300 gallons of diesel #2. Bids came in as follows: Vollan Oil @ \$2.55

per gallon; CHS @ no bid; Brooks Oil @ \$2.6028 per gallon; Coles Petroleum, Inc. at \$2.5560 per gallon. Motion to accept Vollan Oil made by Claggett, seconded by Nebelsick. All in favor-aye. Motion carried.

### **DEPUTY STATE'S ATTORNEY**

Deputy State's Attorney Taylor was present when Auditor Wingert discussed property taxes that were incorrectly collected on TIFs #9 and #23 in April 2025. Collection on one of the TIFs was omitted. The county will need to send out a letter informing the property owner of the mistake that had occurred.

### **CONTINGENCY TRANSFERS**

#### **Resolution #07292025-01 CONTINGENCY TRANSFER**

Whereas, SDCL 7-21-32.2 states that no expenditures shall be charged to the line item authorized for by SDCL 7-21-6.1, but such appropriated amount may be transferred, by resolution of the board, to any other appropriation in which insufficient amounts were provided or for items for which no appropriation was provided. When transfers are made from the contingency budget to other appropriations, whose revenue is provided by other than general fund revenues, a transfer of fund balances may be made from the county general fund to such other fund in the amount of the budget transfer.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the following contingency transfers be made for the 2025 budget year:

Transfer from the General Fund Contingency Budget 112 in the amount of \$15,000 to Elections 120 and \$55,000 to Juvenile Detention 215.
