CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Reider called the Davison County Board of Commissioners meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Kiner, Nebelsick, Blaalid and Chairman Reider. Also present was Auditor Wingert.

PLEDGE

Commissioner Reider opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVE AGENDA

Motion by Nebelsick; second by Claggett to approve the agenda as amended. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Nebelsick; second by Claggett to approve the minutes of the September 16, 2025, meeting. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT

Steve Sibson talked to the board about the property tax meetings he has been attending in Pierre. Steve stated that they are working hard and looking at all angles to try and figure out a good solution for all.

TECH SOLUTIONS

Jordan with Tech Solutions discussed the SECURE SD Grant. Jordan stated this grant will enhance our network equipment, as the county was approved for \$14,000. He and his team will complete the upgrades before the end of the year.

SPN - ROUNDABOUT

A discussion/presentation was held regarding the roundabout at the 23rd and Ohlman intersection. The roundabout was approved by the Mitchell City Council, as they are looking toward the future and developing a plan now based on several traffic studies that were conducted. Joe Schroeder with the City of Mitchell stated that completing this roundabout is a long-term fix for Mitchell/Davison County. The roundabout will cross over onto the county line. Motion by Claggett; second by Nebelsick to approve the city project at no cost to the county. All in favor – aye. Motion carried.

BUDGET DISCUSSION

Motion by Claggett; second by Blaalid to approve \$100,000 in the 111 Commissioners budget in the 2026 calendar year for the purpose of consulting/planning for a new jail/public safety building. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

ADOPT 2026 ANNUAL BUDGET

Motion by Nebelsick; second by Claggett to adopt the 2026 annual budget noting that the following changes were made from the provisional budget: property tax increased to \$8,879,341.00 and cash balance applied decreased to \$2,828,850.84. Commissioners budget (111) had an increase of \$100,000 to be placed in a consulting line item. Roll call vote was held as follows: Claggett - aye, Kiner - aye, Nebelsick - aye, Blaalid - aye, and Reider - aye. Motion carried 5-0.
