Dear Mr. Sweeney:

The Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR) is contacting you regarding the event noted above. A copy of the initial spill report form is enclosed for your review. Based upon the information provided, approximately one ton of dry fertilizer was released due to operator error during the loadout process. The procedures for the assessment and cleanup of spills such as this were developed to protect surface and groundwater resources. In this situation, DANR requires the following (we understand some of these actions may already be completed or underway):

- Scrape up spilled product and contaminated gravel;
- Properly manage spilled product and contaminated gravel either by disposing at a permitted municipal solid waste landfill or by land application (land application must be approved by DANR in advance);
- Provide this office cleanup photos and a copy of disposal receipts (if applicable); and
- By September 30, 2025, please complete and return the attached Written Contamination Incident Follow Up Report form.

Jamison Smith has been assigned as the project manager for this case. He will review the information provided and contact you if further remedial action is necessary.
