The Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources has reviewed the case file for your site. As a result of this review, the Department has determined work at this site can end, and the file can be closed. Based on available information, it appears a release of petroleum has not occurred from these tank systems. Therefore, the Department will not perform any further testing or remediation associated with the tank systems removed on July 21, 2025.

As you know, the tanks were removed from this site as part of South Dakota's Abandoned Storage Tank Program. If problems arise from contamination associated with the tank that may not have been detected, please contact us so that further action may be taken. Should you have any questions or concerns, please contact Justin Allen of my staff. Thank you for your cooperation in protecting the groundwater resources of South Dakota.
