

In the event of an approved disaster declaration, information on Public and Individual Assistance will be provided.

Public Assistance: Jurisdictions have **30 days** from declaration to submit their request for Public Assistance. Applicant briefings to give updates to the program and provide assistance for those wanting to submit requests will be held.

Individual Assistance: Applicants have **60 days** from the date of the declaration to apply for assistance.

Constituents in the declared Individual Assistance counties could also apply for assistance with the methods listed below. **Please note, submitting a self-report damage form via Crisis Track does not count as an application for assistance, affected individuals and businesses are required to fill out an application for assistance using one of the methods below.**
