CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman Blaalid called the meeting of the Davison County Board of Commissioners to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Nebelsick, and Blaalid. Also present was Auditor Wingert. Absent were Chairman Reider and Commissioner Kiner.

PLEDGE

Vice Chairman Blaalid opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVE AGENDA

Motion by Claggett, second by Nebelsick to approve the agenda as amended. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

APPROVE MINUTES

Motion by Nebelsick, second by Claggett to approve the minutes from the 5/19/26 Davison County Commissioner meeting. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

Former Davison County Commissioner Brenda Bode said that when she was a commissioner, she found it very beneficial to take pictures of concerns out of city limits to aid the Highway and Weed Department with areas that need attention.

OPEN 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION CANVASSING - ADOPT CANVASSING BOARD MEMBERS

Vice Chairman Blaalid welcomed Carol Millan and Brenda Bode to the Canvassing Board due to the absence of Commissioners Reider and Kiner.

APPROVE 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION CANVASSING

Motion by Nebelsick, second by Claggett to approve the 2026 Primary Election canvass. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.

DETERMINE PRECINCT AND RACES FOR THE POST-ELECTION ADUIT

Auditor Wingert, in front of the canvassing board, conducted the drawing for the precinct and races to be audited during the post-election audit that will be held at 9:00 A.M. on 6/8/26. Precinct 2 was drawn with the races for US Senate and SD Governor to be audited. Both races have more than 100 ballots cast, therefore Precinct 2 will be the only audited precinct.

Emergency Management would like to purchase the machines now to utilize a \$1,600 rebate by sending in our older machines. Motion by Claggett, second by Nebelsick to allow the purchase of the AED and to utilize the rebate form to get money back for the older machines. All in favor - aye. Motion carried.
