CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Reider called the meeting of the Davison County Board of Commissioners to order at 9:00 A.M. Members of the board present were Claggett, Nebelsick, Blaalid, and Reider. Also present was Auditor Wingert. Absent was Commissioner Kiner.

Chairman Reider opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Grant Temporary Malt Beverage License to
Corn Palace Shrine Club of Mitchell SD
Resolution 090826-01**

Whereas, SDCL 35-4-124 states, in part, that any municipality or county may issue:

- (1) A special malt beverage retailers license in conjunction with a special event within the municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or veterans organization or licensee licensed pursuant to 35-1-111 or subdivision 35-4-2(4), (6) or (16) in addition to any other licenses held by the special events license applicant;
- (2) A special on-sale license in conjunction with a special event within the municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or veterans organization or any licensee licensed pursuant to 35-4-111 or subdivision 35-4-2(a) or (6) in addition to any other licenses held by the special events license applicant; and

Whereas, a public hearing is required for the issuance of a license pursuant to this section if the person/organization applying for the license doesn't hold an on-sale alcoholic beverage license or a retail malt beverage license in the municipality or county; and

Whereas, no persons appeared at the hearing held June 27, 2023, in objection to the issuance of the malt beverage license applied for and no concerns were otherwise expressed, it being noted the location and particulars of the temporarily licensed premises were appropriate for the sale of malt beverages.

Whereas, the fee had previously been set at \$200.00.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that a temporary on-sale malt beverage license be issued to Corn Palace Shrine Club of Mitchell, SD, for a fee of \$200 for the day of 10/23/26 which is held at 3200 W Havens, Mitchell SD with a legal description of SW1/4 S RY & EX LT 1 OF DAVISON COUNTY SUB IN SE1/4 OF SW1/4 MITCHELL TWP Davison County South Dakota.
